- 1. New students must also submit:
 - Request for Records Form
- 2. All students entering Ambassador Christian Academy for the first time will be given an entrance assessment to assist in determining academic and overall readiness for the grade level for which they have applied.
- 3. Kindergarten student must be 5 years old before August 1.
- 4. A final decision regarding admission will be made and the parent of the prospective student will be notified.
- 5. For enrollment to be finalized, arrangements for tuition payments must be completed with the Finance Office: by signing all assurance forms required for School Choice participants, paying for tuition, in full, paying for the first semester of tuition or setting up monthly payments with the Finance Office.
